WHAT IS REQUIRED TO GRADUATE FROM SECONDARY SCHOOL

There are 4 requirements to receive a Secondary School Diploma:

1. You need a total of 54 credits
2. 20 of these credits must come from secondary 5
3. You must pass:
 - Secondary 4 Math
 - Secondary 4 Science
 - Secondary 4 History
 - Art (Drama, Art, Dance or Music)
4. You must pass
 - Secondary 5 English and French*, and,
 - Phys. Ed or Ethics

*To get into Secondary 5 English and French, you must pass Secondary 4 English and French



MINISTRY EXAMS

Ministry exams are also known as uniform examinations, held annually in May and June. Their purpose is to assess students' learning in the 5 'main/core' courses that are needed in secondary 4-5 for certification. One cannot skip or fail any of these courses in order to graduate.

- Mathematics ([Secondary IV](#));
- Science ([Secondary IV](#));
- History of Quebec and Canada ([Secondary IV](#))
- French, as a Second Language (Secondary V)
- English, Language Arts ([Secondary V](#))

**The grading of these exams will be validated and made official
