2. <u>APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA</u>

3. INSURANCE

Resolution – Union réciproque d'assurance scolaire du Québec (URASQ)

CONSIDERING the significant increases in private insurers' premiums for liability insurance coverage over the past five (5) years;

CONSIDERING the conclusions of the actuarial feasibility study of a group of 62 school service centers and school boards demonstrating the feasibility and viability of self-managed insurance in the form of a reciprocal union (hereinafter: the union) provided for in the Act respecting insurers (RLRQ, c. A-32. 1);

CONSIDERING that actuarial analyses show that the viability of the union is based on a commitment by the members for an initial period of five (5) years;

CONSIDERING that participation in the reciprocal union constitutes a level of protection equivalent to, and sometimes superior to, that of the private market;

CONSIDERING that the premiums to be expected over the five (5) years will be equivalent to or lower than the increases to be expected from private insurers, and that the union will thus have accumulated a significant reserve fund for its long-term survival;

CONSIDERING that this was the last year that the Centre d'acquisition gouvernemental (CAG) would offer the possibility to join a purchasing group for Liability insurance;

CONSIDERING that the members of the Council of Commissioners have read the agreement submitted to them;

C24-06-148 IT WAS MOVED BY K. Dickson to join the reciprocal union for the period from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2028; and

THAT the Director general be authorized to sign for and in the name of Eastern Shores School Board the agreement of the members of the reciprocal union and to take all necessary measures or actions to give full effect thereto; and

THAT the Secretary General, Mr. Denis Gauthier, be designated as the representative of the Eastern Shores School Board.
