NATURE OF THE WORK

The principal and customary work of an employee in this class of employment consists in helping teachers and staff responsible for the preparation, presentation, supervision and evaluation of the work related to learning concepts and exercises in the context of vocational training.

CHARACTERISTIC FUNCTIONS

- He or she conducts demonstrations of tasks requiring the use, operation and maintenance of machinery, tools, instruments and accessories as part of the course;
- He or she may be required to perform the duties of monitor or tutor;
- He or she makes sure that the safety rules are observed in performing various tasks and gives examples;
- He or she might have to keep an inventory of equipment and supplies;
- He or she have to keep the equipment and tools used in good condition and, for this purpose, carries out inspections and basic maintenance;
- If need be, he or she performs any other related duty.
