NATURE OF THE WORK

- ➤ He or she may be required to perform the duties of monitor or tutor;
- > He or she makes sure that the safety rules are observed in performing various tasks and gives examples;
- > He or she might have to keep an inventory of equipment and supplies;
- ➤ He or she have to keep the equipment and tools used in good condition and, for this purpose, carries out inspections and basic maintenance;
- If need be, he or she performs any other related duty.
